Dr. Rebecca Larson also gave a presentation about some of her work. She has worked to install small scale digesters to produce gas for cooking. 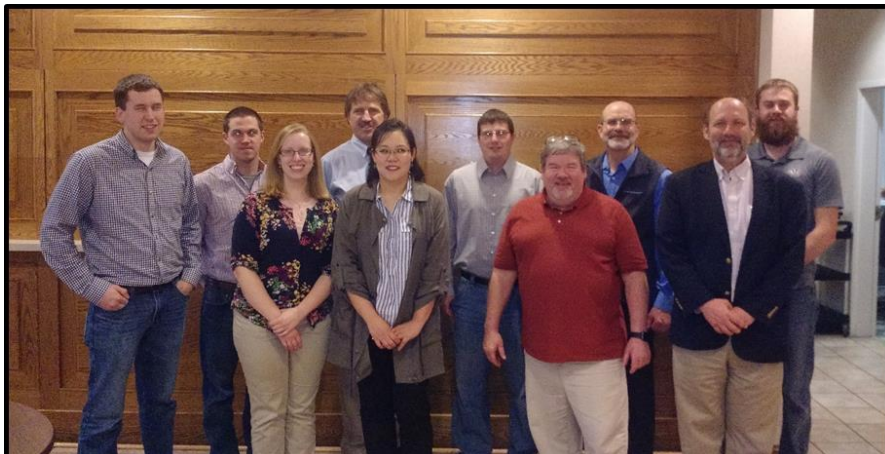
